Rules for the 2023 Western Branch Striking Competition

- 1. Only paid up members of the Western Branch may take part.
- 2. The competition will be in two parts: Test piece and fall and rise.
- **3.** Each team may ring 5 minutes of called changes or 120 changes in any method which may include Plain Hunt.
- **4.** Each team will have up to 5 minutes practice before the test piece.
- **5.** Before commencing the test piece, **2 whole pulls on the treble** will signify the team is ready to start.
- **6.** Marking will commence immediately and finish when the last bell has set.
- 7. If the team is to attempt the fall and rise then 2 whole pulls on the tenor will be the signal to the Judges.
- **8.** Marks will be lost for the non-setting of bells.
- **9.** At the end of the fall, bells may finish in either Rounds or Queens. Bells chiming after this will be penalised.
